TEF believes that no child should fall behind because of financial difficulties. With inequality in education, we must take more progressive measures to break this cycle and think about how we can create equal opportunity for all school-age children. TEF's philosophy focuses on helping students develop to their full potential and putting them on a path for success in life.

With this vision, TEF partners with non-profit organizations in Turkey to provide scholarships to children in low-income families. I had the opportunity to talk with a board member of one of these organizations, Gündoğdu, during my visit to Turkey. Gündoğdu was founded to provide low-income children with monetary support. In a short period of time, though, the organization broadened its focus to include the idea of developing the whole person intellectually, socially and ethically. Gündoğdu volunteers think that education is a society-wide effort with society-wide benefits. Volunteers in seven houses in different remote areas in the city of Izmir are committed to creating well-rounded individuals, who will enlighten their social circles.

Gündoğdu is one of the many organizations TEF supports with your donations. Last year TEF provided scholarships to over 450 students through Gündoğdu, Çağdaş Yaşamı Destekleme Derneği, Anadolu Çağdaş Eğitim Vakfı, Kadın Sorunları Araştırma Derneği and Darüşşafaka. This year we are increasing the number of students we serve, help them continue their education and become good citizens.

Number of Scholarships Reached 500

This school year the number of TEF scholarships for middle and high schools students reached 500. This is a record high. The scholarship funds for these students totaled \$160,763.
